

2022- 23 Youth Rep Travel League Rules

- 1) For the 2022-23 YTL Season, each center can send up to 3 Teams, 4 Trios, 6 Doubles and 12 Singles for each division to their corresponding events. Each team can be made up anyway they choose, as there are no gender requirements for the teams.
- 2) Teams are allowed to bring up Bantams to the Junior Division, or Juniors to the Senior Division to fill up their rosters.
- 3) There will be four regular season events throughout the season as well as a final event. For the four regular season events, each event will have a different format. There will be a team, doubles, trios and singles event.
- 4) Teams will be 3 games, Doubles, Trios and Singles will be 4 game events.
- 5) All events will be based off 90% handicap. Teams will be based off 1000, doubles will be based off 500, trios will be based off 750 and singles will be based off 250. Each Event Top 3 will be paid out, along with Top 3 Individual Scratch and Handicapped Bowlers. For the Single's Event, it will only the Top 3 Individual Scratch and Handicapped Bowlers will be paid out.
- 6) All Competitors will use their highest league average (in all leagues) with a minimum of 9 games. Tournament Averages will be as follows:
 - First Event 100% League Average
 - Second Event 75% League Average / 25% YTL Average
 - Third Event 50% League Average / 50% YTL Average
 - Fourth Event 25% League Average / 75% YTL Average
 - Finals 100% YTL Average
- 7) Must have a total of 11 games in the regular events to eligible for the Season Single Awards and 11 games to be eligible to participate in the Playoffs.
- 8) Player of the Year Awards will be handed out in each division. Player of the Year award will be determined by a point system based off the bowlers' individual totals (like Master Bowlers Association Tournament Singles Point System). The players best 3 out of 4 will be used to determine the Player of the Year.
- 9) Late bowlers will be awarded 0 for any missed frames or may take a doe score of 90% of their average. Absent bowlers will take a doe score of 90% of their average.
- 10) All C5 Rules and Regulations are in effect. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will have a zero tolerance at any YTL Event.
- 11) Dress Code is neat and tidy.
- 12) Cost will be \$15.00 per bowler. All monies will be Prize Money. All Lineage is paid for by the Edmonton 5 Pin Bowlers' Association.
