

2024 Youth Challenge Qualifications/Rules

1. Open to all bowlers 12 years of age and not 19 years of age as of December 31, 2023
2. Bowlers must hold a valid A5PBA card to participate.
3. Personalized bowling balls will be allowed and the balls MUST BE ENGRAVED with identifying letters or symbols for ball registration and identification purposes.
4. The roll-offs will operate on total pinfall for 10 games (2 Day - (NO HANDICAP) and will be governed by the Canadian 5 Pin Bowlers Association rules.
5. The 1st contingent will be made up of the top 7 girls, top 7 boys, with the 15th position being the next highest qualifier (male/ female). They will compete at the Provincial Championships being held in Calgary, AB on February 2-3, 2024.
6. The top three men and three ladies at the Provincial Championships, will advance to the Canadian National Championships being held March 20-24, 2024.
7. In the event of a tie for 1st, 5th or final qualifying positions of a contingent, a one game roll-off will be held to determine the final placing.
8. A5PBA DRESS CODE will apply to all youth bowlers for all rounds of these tournaments (see attached Dress Code).
9. The winners must be able to attend all practices and are responsible to the Coaches and Team Manager.
10. Edmonton 5 Pin Bowling Association has adopted a Zero Tolerance policy for all sanctioned youth bowling tournaments. It is expected all youth bowlers to behave in a professional manner and the treatment of any youth bowlers in abrasive or humiliating manner will not be tolerated.

Participants using drugs, alcoholic beverages or showing disorderly conduct during the Zone and /or Provincial Championships will be disqualified. This rule applies to both on or off the lanes and will be strictly enforced throughout the tournament.

(No fluorescent colours, denims, stirrups, spandex, leggings, harem, ruggers or sweat pants of any kind)

NO HATS OR CAPS (Unless worn for religious or medical reasons)

BOWLERS DISREGARDING THE "DRESS CODE" WILL BE ASKED TO CHANGE OR BE SUBJECT TO A FINE

Bowlers should be aware that this Dress Code may apply to "Zone" and "Regional" level playoffs for Alberta 5 Pin Bowlers Association events and should check with the playoff Tournament Chairman
